DIY Pinecone Bird Feeder

These bird feeders are fun and easy for kids to make. When it's done, kids can watch their new feathered friends enjoy!

- ▶ Large open pinecones (Or use a small plastic cup, empty toilet paper roll, cut-out cardboard, or ice cream cone)
- ▶ Peanut butter
- ▶ Birdseed
- ▶ Twine/String

Cut a piece of twine about 10 inches long and tie it to the top of your pinecone. Tie the ends of the twine together, so you'll be able to hang the feeder. Attach the twine to the pinecone before you add the peanut butter and birdseed - it will be less messy that way! Spread some peanut butter onto the pinecone, covering as much as possible. Roll the pinecone in birdseed, covering as much peanut butter as you can. Hang your new bird feeder outdoors for birds to enjoy. Pick a spot that you can watch the birds from inside!
