# Cinnamon / Gingerbread Man Ornament

- Combine 1 cup of cinnamon, 1 cup of applesauce, and 2 tbsp craft glue (optional).
- Roll out your dough to a thickness between 1/3" and 1/2".
- Cut out fun, festive shapes with cookie cutters.
- · We recommend a gingerbread man shape, if you have one.
- Use the tip of a straw to poke a hole at the top to hang the ornament from.
- Bake at 250° F for 2–3 hours, or until the ornaments are dry and hard.
- Let cool and decorate with paint, glue, glitter or whatever you'd like!
- Attach a string to the top and tie it so you can hang it on the tree once it's dry.



# **Christmas Cookies**

### What you will need:

- ⇒ ½ cup unsalted butter, softened
- ⇒ 1 (8 oz) package cream cheese, softened
- ⇒ 1 white cake mix package
- ⇒ 1 egg
- ⇒ 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ⇒ ½ cup sprinkles, divided
- ⇒ ½ cup confectioner's sugar



### How to make it:

- ⇒ Cream together the butter and cream cheese, add egg and vanilla and beat until combined, beat in cake mix until well blended, stir in ¼ cup of sprinkles, refrigerate at least one hour.
- ⇒ Preheat oven to 350° F.
- ⇒ Grease cookie sheet or line with parchment paper.
- ⇒ Scoop out rounded tablespoons of dough and roll into 1-inch balls.
- ⇒ Coat ball with sprinkles then roll into confectioner's sugar until completely covered
- ⇒ Place 2 inches apart onto cookie sheet.
- ⇒ Bake 8–10 minutes, allow cookies to cool on the baking sheet for a few minutes before moving, or eating!
