May Day Challenge

Did you know the 1st day of May is often referred to as May Day? It's a day to celebrate Spring! Many people celebrate with fresh flowers, while others like to continue the tradition of giving May Day Baskets. Not only is giving May Day Baskets really fun, it's super easy! Dollar Dog wants to challenge all of his savers to make 10 May Day Baskets and deliver them to friends and neighbors. This act of kindness can really brighten up someone's day, and Dollar Dog loves to see kindness!

You'll need:

- small paper or plastic cups, to be the basket
- craft pipe cleaners – poke a hole in the top of each side of the cup and attach as a handle
- Fill your basket with small flowers, toys or food items such as candy, popcorn, jelly beans, suckers, etc...
- Tape a Happy May Day note to the handle or basket made with construction paper.



Grow Your Own Bean Plant!

Spring is all about rebirth and growing new life! Farmers plant their crops in the spring and many animals have their babies in the spring – like cows, birds and ducks! Let's explore together to grow a bean plant! Here's what you need:

- Glass jar / cup
- Dried Lima Beans /Butter Beans
- Cotton Balls
- Water

- Pull apart the cotton balls slightly to break up the fibers.
- Stuff cotton balls at the bottom of the glass jar, half full.
- Stick one bean on either side of the jar, in between the glass and cotton balls so we can watch them root and grow.
- Lightly water cotton balls so they are damp, but not soaking wet.
- Place the jar next to a window to get plenty of sunlight. Now we wait!
- Your beans should start to grow roots in about 2-3 days! You'll slowly see it sprout up and be very green. Keep checking the cotton balls every day to make sure they feel damp. We don't want them to dry out while they are growing!
