ATTENTION STUDENTS GRADES K - 12:

We love to see students succeeding in school, and now you can be rewarded for it! Bucks for Brains is new for the 2018-2019 school year and will reward students \$1.00 for every 'A' on their report card! (Maximum of \$8.00 per student per school quarter)

Here's how it works:

- Student must be present in the branch and bring in their official report card providing final quarterly grades.
- Report card must be from the current school year and not more than 2 months old.
- Test grades, paper grades, or assignment grades DO NOT qualify.
- For schools that do not grade on an ABCDF scale, a 'passing' or 'highly satisfactory' report may be considered equivalent to an 'A'.
- Maximum of \$8.00 per student per school quarter.
- Student must be a C1st member and have a consistent positive account balance.
- Student (member) will be required to sign their name to receive the cash reward.

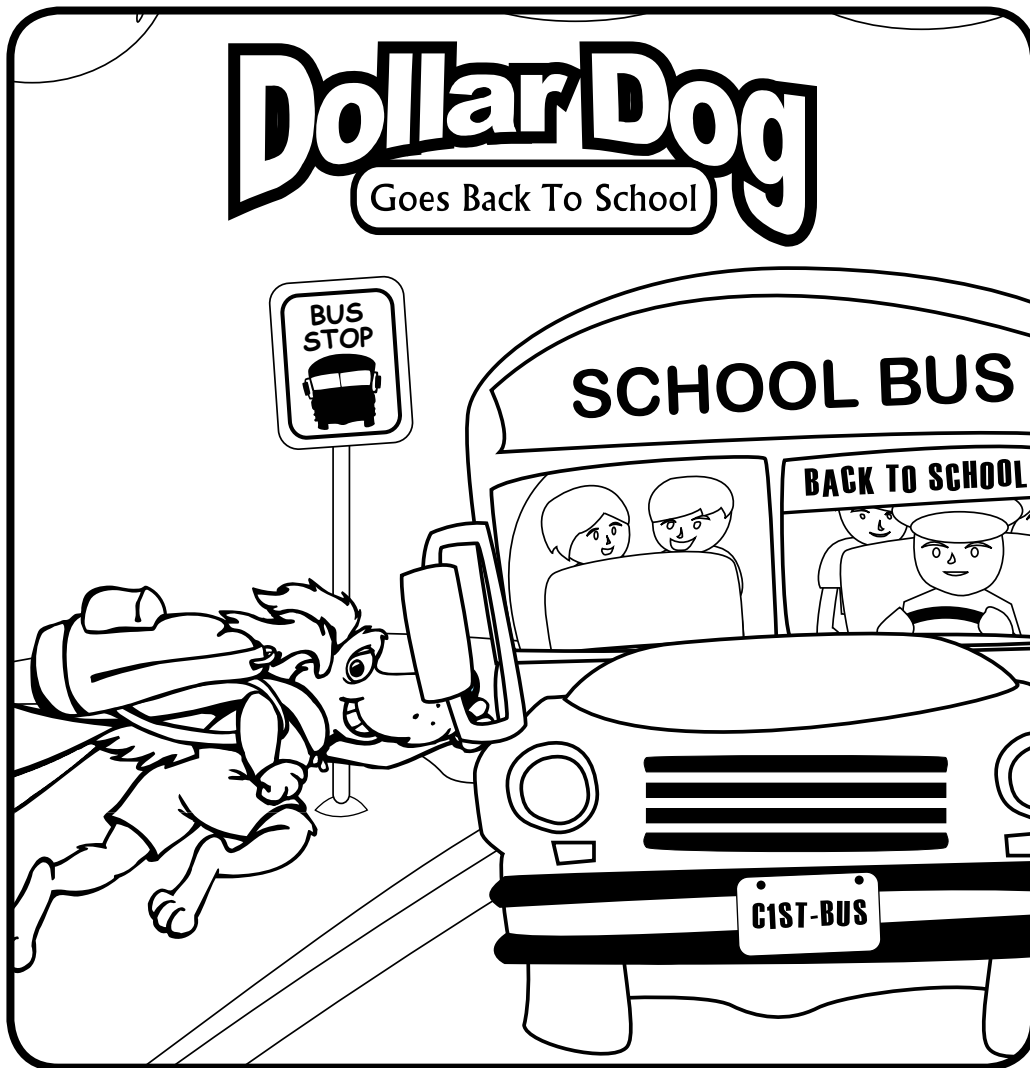


Upcoming Events!

Ocean in a Bottle

The closest thing we have to an ocean in Iowa is a muddy lake, but how cool would it be to carry around an ocean in your backpack or have it sitting on your nightstand?

You'll need: Plastic bottle with a cap, baby oil OR cooking oil (best if oil is clear), water, blue food coloring, funnel, duct tape
Optional: glitter, sand, small toys, sea shells

- Instructions:**
1. Fill the plastic bottle with 1/3 water and the rest oil
 2. Add 1 - 2 drops of blue food coloring
 3. Add any small items you desire like the glitter, sand, toys, etc..
 4. Secure the cap on the bottle with duct tape.
 5. Oil and water don't mix, so the oil creates slow waves in the water when you turn it back and forth - just like the ocean!
