**New Corporate Center Located In Ottumwa**

Most recently, we moved into the new Corporate Center at 1100 Hutchinson Ave. in northeast Ottumwa. The Corporate Center provides office space, conference rooms and training facilities for approximately 75 administration and support employees with growth capacity for an additional 25. The single story, unique-designed, curved structure features parking space for 130 vehicles and convenient accessibility to the four-lane, Ottumwa bypass. It allows us to consolidate multiple departments under one roof, creating significantly more efficiency and collaboration. Most of all, Ottumwa is our home and this project solidifies our

commitment to serve the community and surrounding areas.

Last month, the Des Moines Register published The 2019 Iowa Top Workplaces, a list of best places to work in Iowa. I am thrilled to let you know C1st has been named to the list for the fourth year in a row. The employer honor is based on results of an employee feedback survey. We're honored to have been selected for the award, and I'm proud of our staff for being a strong and empowered team.

When we say 'people helping people' is what we're all about, we back it up – and come together to give back. The inaugural C1st Foundation grants totaling \$18,500 were awarded this summer to community projects in Centerville, Albia, Eddyville, Blakesburg, Cedar Rapids, Ottumwa, and Washington. We organized the foundation efforts in December, 2016 and after over two years of accumulating funds, the first check presentations were recently made. The non-profit awards included:

- ⇒ Albia Rotary Club -- \$2,500 for a restroom facility at the Albia Reservoir
- ⇒ Blakesburg PTO -- \$2,500 for a baseball field by the school playground
- ⇒ Centerville Police Reserves -- \$2,500 for taser and equipment funding
- ⇒ Eddyville PTO -- \$1,000 for a new playground at Eddyville Elementary
- ⇒ Iowa Food Bank -- \$2,500 for food safety equipment at their Ottumwa warehouse
- ⇒ Tanager Place LGBTQ Youth Center -- \$5,000 to aid in their after school and weekend programs
- ⇒ Washington Middle School -- \$2,500 to add appliances in a special education life skills classroom

The C1st Foundation supports causes close to our heart, such as education/financial literacy, mental wellness/suicide prevention, and community betterment. The project awards are made possible by grants from the C1st Credit Union Impact Giving Fund of the Greater Cedar Rapids Community Foundation.

- Ability to read and interpret financial statements
- Act in the best interest of the Community 1st Credit Union membership at all times

Nominations received after the closing date or incomplete nominations shall be disqualified by the Secretary. There will be no nominations from the floor. Election results will be announced at the annual meeting.
